

Corrections Academy Training

Credit Recommendation Guide

The (state) Basic Corrections Academy training has been evaluated by the College of Security and Criminal Justice to potentially fulfill 6 required course of study credits in the AACJS 001 program for students enrolled in the AACJS 001 program. Student enrolled in the BSCJA v. 005 program would be eligible to waive 6 General Education Elective credits and 9 required course of study credits in the BSCJA v. 005 program, unless specified otherwise in policy or limited by the state or jurisdiction of a student's residence.
