Credit Recommendation Guide

The Nebraska POST Academy training has been evaluated by the College of Criminal Justice and Security to potentially fulfill 6 required course of study credits in the AACJ 001 program for students enrolled in the AACJ 001 program. Student enrolled in the BSCJA v. 005 program would be eligible to waive 6 General Education Elective credits and 24 required course of study credits in the BSCJA v. 005 program, unless specified otherwise in policy or limited by the state or jurisdiction of a student's residence.

The Nebraska POST Academy training has also been evaluated by the School of Business to potentially fulfill up to 18 lower-division Interdisciplinary or elective credits within any Undergraduate Business program.

To receive any credits recommended below, students will need to submit a PLA application, proof of completion for their respective Nebraska POST Academy training, and a course waiver form. There are fees associated with your PLA submission. However, you may be eligible for PLA benefits. Please contact your Academic Advisor for more information.

University of Phoenix Equivalency: General Education or Elective category to which credit can be applied.

Combinable: Courses may only be combined with courses of similar content and General Education/Elective areas.

Non-Academic: Lack of college level theory and/or principle necessary for credit recognition. Company specific and skill-based training.

Too Few Hours: Courses/training that cannot receive credit because they are less than 1 hour total in length. Similar content in a 1(+) hour timeframe may be eligible for credit.

Applicable Hours: Indicates the total amount of actual learning time. Any breaks or lunch time included in the initial clock hours have been removed.

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*Credit will be awarded for completion of the entire program. If the entire program was not completed, students may be awarded credit for individual courses as listed in the program breakdown.
