### Credit Recommendation Guide

The New Mexico POST Academy training has been evaluated by the College of Criminal Justice and Security to potentially fulfill 6 required course of study credits in the AACJ 001 program for students enrolled in the AACJ 001 program. Student enrolled in the BSCJA v. 005 program would be eligible to waive 6 General Education Elective credits and 24 required course of study credits in the BSCJA v. 005 program, unless specified otherwise in policy or limited by the state or jurisdiction of a student's residence.

The New Mexico POST Academy training has also been evaluated by the School of Business to potentially fulfill up to 18 lower-division Interdisciplinary or elective credits within any Undergraduate Business program.

To receive any credits recommended below, students will need to submit a PLA application, proof of completion for their respective New Mexico POST Academy training, and a course waiver form. There are fees associated with your PLA submission. However, you may be eligible for PLA benefits. Please contact your Academic Advisor for more information.
