Company specific and skill-based training. **Too Few Hours:** Courses/training that cannot receive credit because they are less than 1 hour total in length. Similar content in a 1(+) hour timeframe may be eligible for credit. **Applicable Hours:** Indicates the total amount of actual learning time. Any breaks or lunch time included in the initial clock hours have been removed.
