

CACREP Program Outcomes Report 2017

Arizona campuses (Phoenix and Southern Arizona)

In May 2017, 112 students were enrolled in the University's CACREP®-accredited Clinical Mental Health Counseling (CMHC) program at the Arizona campuses. Between June 1, 2016, and May 31, 2017, 63 students graduated. Approximately 55 percent of students who were admitted to the CMHC program between Sept. 1, 2012, and Aug. 31, 2013, completed the program within the expected time period. As reported by National Board for Certified Counselors (NBCC), the pass rate for graduates from the Arizona campuses who took the National Counselor Examination for Licensure and Certification (NCE®) exam between June 1, 2016, and May 31, 2017, was 87 percent.

In accordance with CACREP policy, to calculate the job placement rate the University surveyed graduates within 180 days following graduation. Forty-one percent (26 out of 63) of graduates responded to the survey. Of the graduates who responded, eighty five percent (22 out of 26) reported having either (i) found full-time placement in a recognized occupation for which the program prepared them; (ii) enrolled in a doctoral program; or (iii) accepted full-time occupational placement as a volunteer (i.e., with an international relief organization) within their field of training or a related field. Non-responses to the survey did not factor into the placement rate.

Utah Campus

In May 2017, 100 students were enrolled in the University's CACREP-accredited CMHC program at the Utah Campus. Between June 1, 2016, and May 31, 2017, 42 students graduated. Approximately 71 percent of students who were admitted to the CMHC program between Sept. 1, 2012, and Aug. 31, 2013, completed the program within the expected time period. The NCE is not required for licensure in Utah, though some students may take it outside of the program. Under those circumstances, NBCC does not report results to the institution.

In accordance with CACREP policy, to calculate the job placement rate the University surveyed graduates within 180 days following graduation. Thirty-seven percent (16 out of 43) of graduates responded to the survey. Of the graduates who responded, eighty eight percent (14 out of 16) reported having either (i) found full-time placement in a recognized occupation for which the program prepared them; (ii) enrolled in a doctoral program; or (iii) accepted full-time occupational placement as a volunteer (i.e., with an international relief organization) within their field of training or a related field. Non-responses to the survey did not factor into the placement rate.
