Identify your audience

Get clear on the industry, company and role you're targeting, so you know who you're aiming to influence with your message.



Personalize your letter

Customize your message instead of using the same cover letter for every employer. Express genuine interest in the company and address your letter to a specific person.

Understand the pain points

Research the company's goals, performance and current way of operating to show them you have an informed perspective about the challenges and opportunities they face.

Be a solution

Share a few success stories of how you've solved

similar problems in the past and why you're passionate about your work. Detail the skills, results and measurable outcomes that support your story.

Find the right tone & voice

Don't be overly formal or impersonal. Find a tone and voice appropriate for the company culture but be your authentic self.
