

# The Phoenix Bachelor's Scholarship – November 2025

Section	Description
Summary	<p>All new students or students who have been out of attendance for over 365 days who i) apply for and enroll in a University of Phoenix bachelor's degree program; (ii) have three year's work experience and (iii) apply for this Phoenix Bachelor's Scholarship – November 2025 ("Scholarship") prior to the deadline and register and post attendance in their first class between November 1<sup>st</sup>, 2025 and November 30<sup>th</sup>, 2025 ("Initial Attendance Window") will receive a scholarship worth up to a maximum of \$1,000 each, distributed over 20 courses.</p> <p><b>NOTE:</b> Students must begin the admissions application prior to completing this scholarship application.</p>
Application Deadline	<p>The Scholarship application will be made available online on October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2025. Applications must be completed and submitted online at <a href="http://www.phoenix.edu">www.phoenix.edu</a> by 11:59pm MST November 30<sup>th</sup>, 2025 ("Application Deadline"). Applications submitted after the Application Deadline will not be considered. No exceptions.</p>
Eligibility Criteria	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Applicants currently residing in the United States must meet one of the following requirements: be a legal resident of the United States; have been granted permanent residency; have a valid visa that does not prohibit educational studies; have been granted temporary protected status along with approved Notice of Action issued by Citizen Immigration Services and verified through CIS Form g-845; or have been granted asylum along with the approved Notice of Action issued by the Citizen Immigration Services.</li> <li>2. Applicant must meet all admissions requirements of University of Phoenix if selected as a scholarship recipient.</li> <li>3. Applicant must not be an employee (including full- and part-time faculty) or a family member (spouse, dependent child, or domestic partner) of an employee of University of Phoenix or any other affiliate of University of Phoenix, Inc.</li> <li>4. Applicant must apply and be admitted to a University of Phoenix bachelor's degree program.</li> <li>5. Applicant must submit a complete, signed application, together with all supporting documentation by the Application Deadline. The completion of the application form does not create an obligation to award a scholarship to the applicant. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. As part of the scholarship application, the applicant must certify that they have three years of work experience.</li> </ol> </li> <li>6. Applicant must post attendance to their first bachelor's degree course within the Initial Attendance Window.</li> </ol>
Selection Process	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. The recipients of the scholarships will be selected by the University of Phoenix.</li> </ol>

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	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>2. It is the applicant's responsibility to submit a complete and signed application along with any required and supporting documentation, which must be received on or before the Application Deadline. The University of Phoenix accepts no responsibility for incomplete applications, applications not in proper form, lost applications, or any other submission in exception to the instructions.</li> <li>3. Scholarship selection shall be made without regard to race, color, religion, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity, age, national origin, disability, veteran status, or any other category protected by federal, state, or local law.</li> <li>4. The decision of the University of Phoenix is final and not subject to review.</li> <li>5. Starting on December 1<sup>st</sup>, 2025, the University of Phoenix will begin the selection process for eligible qualified students.</li> <li>6. Recipients will be notified no later than January 8<sup>th</sup>, 2026.</li> </ol>
Scholarship Award Distribution and Timing	<p>The University of Phoenix will determine and notify the recipients of the scholarships upon validation.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. The maximum scholarship award is \$1,000. The Scholarship shall be disbursed as a credit toward the student's tuition payments at a rate of \$50 per course beginning with the student's first attended course and thereafter for those continuously attended courses in their bachelor's program until: (i) the student has maximized the \$1,000 Scholarship amount, or (ii) two years (730 days) has elapsed from the student's first course start date notwithstanding any approved leave of absence(s), or (iii) the student graduates from their program, whichever comes first. Subsections (i)-(iii) are collectively hereinafter referred to as "Terminating Events".</li> <li>2. Only the applicants selected as Scholarship recipients will be notified by the University of Phoenix.</li> </ol>
Maintenance Requirements	<p>In order to continue disbursement of the scholarship award, applicant must meet the following maintenance requirements:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Applicant must remain in a bachelor's program (all coursework attended must be program applicable courses). Awards will only be applied to courses taken as part of their bachelor's program, specific to the original program level award.</li> <li>2. Applicant must successfully pass each course attempted in accordance with their program's requirements as outlined in the academic catalog for all courses. Any withdrawals or courses not successfully passed in accordance with the program requirements will terminate the scholarship.</li> <li>3. Applicant may not have an unapproved attendance gap greater than 35 days.</li> </ol>

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Terms and Conditions	<p data-bbox="451 233 1398 405">By applying for a University of Phoenix scholarship and/or accepting the scholarship award, the applicant and/or recipient agrees to the following terms and conditions. All application submissions shall become the property of University of Phoenix, Inc. regardless of applicant being awarded the scholarship. In addition, applicant agrees to execute a University of Phoenix, Inc. Scholarship award is a non-cash award to recipient's University of Phoenix account as outlined on the scholarship application. Scholarship will be applied to the first credit-bearing class with a start date after the award date. No scholarship funds will be applied to previous classes or currently enrolled classes at the time of scholarship award. No check or other cash monies will be disbursed at any time. This Scholarship is not applicable and will not be issued to: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. Applicants who enroll in a University of Phoenix degree level or program other than what is specifically outlined in the Application's Eligibility Criteria for the scholarship.</li> <li>b. Applicants pursuing stand-alone University of Phoenix courses.</li> <li>c. Applicants pursuing stand-alone University of Phoenix certificates.</li> <li>d. Applicants pursuing a Competency Based Education program.</li> <li>e. Current University of Phoenix Students</li> <li>f. University of Phoenix Alumni</li> <li>g. Applicants receiving any employer benefits or discounts</li> <li>h. Applicants receiving Military Tuition Rate</li> <li>i. Applicants who are receiving the AA Transfer tuition rate</li> <li>j. Applicants who do not meet the University of Phoenix eligibility requirements</li> <li>k. Students who enroll and start their first course outside the scholarship window</li> <li>l. The Scholarship will automatically terminate if: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. Applicant fails to meet the eligibility requirements</li> <li>b. Recipient is Academically Disqualified, Disqualified for Admission, Scholastically Disqualified, Scholastically Suspended or Expelled as outlined in the University Catalog.</li> <li>c. Recipient is out of attendance on an unapproved leave of absence for more than 35 days.</li> <li>d. Recipient completes their bachelor's degree program.</li> <li>e. Receives the maximum scholarship award</li> <li>f. Two years (730 days) from the start date of recipient's first course notwithstanding any approved leave of absence(s).</li> </ol> </li> <li>7. If recipient has applied for or is receiving Title IV financial aid funding, this scholarship may reduce the recipient's eligibility for Title IV financial aid funding to comply with Title IV regulations. In addition, the recipient must maintain continuous attendance as defined by the University of Phoenix and/or must qualify for a leave of absence to maintain his/her financial aid status. Recipient is required to abide by all state and federal financial aid policies and procedures and all University of Phoenix financial policies and procedures as set forth in the University of Phoenix Academic Catalog, including remaining in good financial standing with University of Phoenix.</li> <li>8.
