

The Spring Transfer Student Bachelor’s Scholarship – February 2025

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| Summary | <p>All new or re-enroll (out of attendance for > 365 days) students who transfer to the University of Phoenix and who (i) apply for and enroll in a University of Phoenix bachelor’s degree program; (ii) have completed and transfer in at least 12 but no more than 60 credits combined transfer credits from accredited institution(s); and (iii) apply for this Transfer Student Bachelor’s Scholarship – February 2025 (“Scholarship”) prior to the deadline and register and post attendance in their first class between February 1st, 2025 and February 28th, 2025 (“Initial Attendance Window”) will receive a scholarship worth up to a maximum of \$3,000 each, distributed over twenty courses.</p> <p>NOTE: Students must begin the admissions application prior to completing this scholarship application.</p> |
| Application Deadline | <p>The Scholarship application will be made available online on January 1st, 2025. Applications must be completed and submitted online at www.phoenix.edu by 11:59pm MST February 28th, 2025 (“Application Deadline”). Applications submitted after the Application Deadline will not be considered. No exceptions.</p> |
| Eligibility Criteria | <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Applicants currently residing in the United States must meet one of the following requirements: be a legal resident of the United States; have been granted permanent residency; have a valid visa that does not prohibit educational studies; have been granted temporary protected status along with approved Notice of Action issued by Citizen Immigration Services and verified through CIS Form g-845; or have been granted asylum along with the approved Notice of Action issued by the Citizen Immigration Services. 2. Applicant must meet all admissions requirements of University of Phoenix if selected as a scholarship recipient. 3. Applicant must not be an employee (including full- and part-time faculty) or a family member (spouse, dependent child, or domestic partner) of an employee of University of Phoenix or any other affiliate of University of Phoenix, Inc. 4. Applicant must apply and be admitted to a University of Phoenix bachelor’s degree program. 5. Applicant must submit a complete, signed application, together with all supporting documentation by the Application Deadline. The completion of the application form does not create an obligation to award a scholarship to the applicant. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. As part of the scholarship application, the student declares that they have between 12 and 60 combined transfer credits from previous institutions. |

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| | <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Applicant must post attendance to their first bachelor’s degree course within the Initial Attendance Window. |
| Selection Process | <ol style="list-style-type: none"> The recipients of the scholarships will be selected by the University of Phoenix. It is the applicant’s responsibility to submit a complete and signed application along with any required and supporting documentation, which must be received on or before the Application Deadline. The University of Phoenix accepts no responsibility for incomplete applications, applications not in proper form, lost applications, or any other submission in exception to the instructions. Scholarship selection shall be made without regard to race, color, religion, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity, age, national origin, disability, veteran status, or any other category protected by federal, state, or local law. The decision of the University of Phoenix is final and not subject to review. Starting on March 1st, 2025, the University of Phoenix will begin the selection process for eligible qualified students. Recipients will be notified no later than April 8th, 2025. |
| Scholarship Award Distribution and Timing | <p>The University of Phoenix will determine and notify the recipients of the scholarships upon validation.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> The maximum scholarship award is \$3,000. The Scholarship shall be disbursed as a credit toward the student’s tuition payments at a rate of \$150 per course beginning with the student’s first attended course and thereafter for those continuously attended courses in their bachelor’s program until: (i) the student has maximized the \$3,000 Scholarship amount, or (ii) two years (730 days) has elapsed from the student’s first course start date notwithstanding any approved leave of absence(s), or (iii) the student graduates from their program, whichever comes first. Subsections (i)-(iii) are collectively hereinafter referred to as “Terminating Events”. Only the applicants selected as Scholarship recipients will be notified by the University of Phoenix. |
| Maintenance Requirements | <p>In order to continue disbursement of the scholarship award, applicant must meet the following maintenance requirements:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Applicant must remain in a bachelor’s program (all coursework attended must be program applicable courses). Awards will only be applied to courses taken as part of their bachelor’s program, specific to the original program level award. Applicant must successfully pass each course attempted in accordance with their program's requirements as outlined in the academic catalog for all courses. Any withdrawals or courses not successfully passed in |

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| | <p>accordance with the program requirements will terminate the scholarship.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 3. Applicant must maintain a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or better for all courses. 4. Applicant may not have an unapproved attendance gap greater than 35 days. |
| <p>Terms and Conditions</p> | <p>By applying for a University of Phoenix scholarship and/or accepting the scholarship award, the applicant and/or recipient agrees to the following terms and conditions. Failure to abide by any of the following terms and conditions shall result in either disqualification of the scholarship award or termination of the scholarship award.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Scholarship award is a non-cash award to recipient's University of Phoenix account as outlined on the scholarship application. Scholarship will be applied to the first credit-bearing class with a start date after the award date. No scholarship funds will be applied to previous classes or currently enrolled classes at the time of scholarship award. No check or other cash monies will be disbursed at any time. No exceptions. <p>The University of Phoenix treats this tuition scholarship, in the form of a non-cash award, as non-taxable income. However, the recipient is encouraged to seek independent counsel from a certified tax consultant as recipient is responsible for all other costs, liabilities, and obligations including any applicable taxes from the award of this scholarship as Federal laws may change and laws vary from state to state. If recipient has applied for or is receiving Title IV financial aid funding, this scholarship may reduce the recipient's eligibility for Title IV financial aid funding to comply with Title IV regulations. In addition, the recipient must maintain continuous attendance as defined by the University of Phoenix and/or must qualify for a leave of absence to maintain his/her financial aid status. During the term of the scholarship, recipient shall notify University of Phoenix immediately if he/she is convicted of a crime, excluding traffic offenses.
